

Violations of SGP 601

On September 9, 2022, UniServ Adam Weber and HACCEA Vice President (FT) Caroline Mellinger met with HACC's Interim Vice President of Human Resources and their attorney, John Audi to discuss violations of Shared Governance Policy 601: Credit Enrollment, Withdrawals, Attendance, and Refunds.

HACC recognized that the evidence presented by the union regarding students being put into classes post-start date without faculty permission was legitimate. They agreed that the College must follow policy under the conditions of status-quo. As such, students must make contact with a faculty member who is then allowed to decide whether or not to allow a student into a class that has already started.

A memo was sent to all advisors, and a meeting was held to ensure that the advisors understood the policy.

The policy does state that faculty have <u>one</u> business day to respond to student emails about class enrollment during the first week of classes. Faculty do need to check and respond to email daily at the beginning of the semester.
